 The federal lobbyist from PORAC are pushing this bill.

B. PAC Committee Report – Angelique Ashby – SB 1058 Bill Updates

- a. Currently this bill would affect 7 different counties –
 Sacramento, Sonoma, Monterey, Riverside, Kern, Orange,
 Santa Clara
- b. This bill would affect 180 personnel statewide. If all of the
 agencies were fully staffed, it would affect approximately 220
 personnel statewide.
- c. Multiple other unions and chiefs have also stated they would
 support the bill.
- d. A meeting will be held with CSAC and the state lobbyist to
 help gain more support.
- e. The 30 days waiting period is almost over, and then the bill
 will go out to committee.
- f. All Sacramento County board of supervisors have been made
 aware of the bill, and everyone has stated they would support
 the bill. They will give a letter of support from the collective
 board.

- g. David Villanueva, the county executive, is also in support of this bill. He is willing to give a letter of support through his legislative person.

- a. The executive board has now met with all Supervisors. They were all supportive of SCCJEU.
